Recruiters like to see that you have ambition. Think about where you would like your career to go and don't be afraid to aim high!



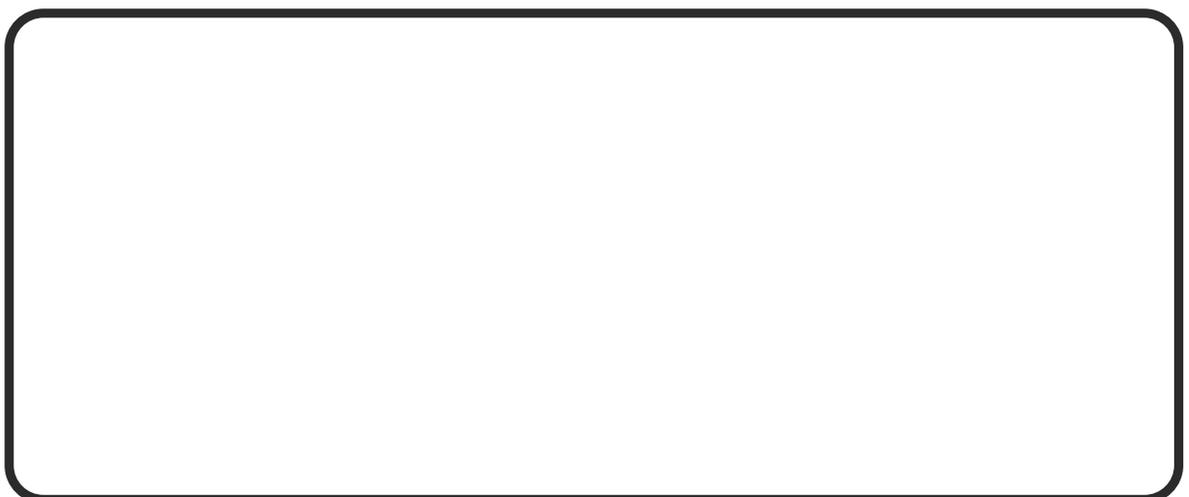
## Information about the company:

## Information about myself:

Note your strengths and how you have played to them in situations in the past (give examples). Think about attributes you possess that make you suitable for the role. Finally, consider your weaknesses. Recruiters want to see that you are aware of your weaknesses and are able to manage them.



## My top three strengths:

Choose your top three strengths from the section above. Memorise them (and your examples of using them). You could write them down and take them with you or put them on a Belbin GetSet Strengths Card if you have one. You might find it helpful to have one in your pocket in case your mind goes blank prior to the interview.
